

# DIRECTIONS TO THE PROJECT MANAGEMENT EDUCATION CENTER



**Our Project Management Education Center in Tucson is located at:  
310 South Williams Blvd, Suite 160, Tucson, AZ, 85711**

### Coming from I-10 North:

Head south on I-10. Take exit 251 for Sunset Rd. Stay on N Frontage Road until you reach W Ruthrauff Road. Turn left, and follow W Ruthrauff Road until it turns into W Wetmore Rd. Keep going until you reach N Oracle Road. Turn right on N Oracle Road, and then left on W Fort Lowell Road. Drive 4 miles, until you reach N Alvernon Road. Turn right and drive for another 3 miles. Turn left at E Broadway Blvd and then right on S Williams Blvd. (If you hit S Craycroft Rd, you've missed the turning). Continue down S Williams Blvd until you see the sign for 310 S Williams Blvd. Turn right and enter the parking lot - we are suite 160.

### Coming from I-10 South:

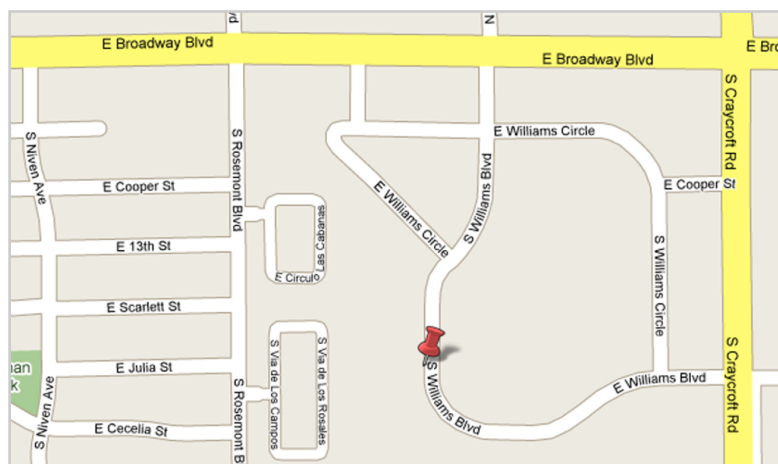
Head north on I-10. Take exit 265 toward Alvernon Way N. Merge into S Alvernon Way. Keep left, and the road becomes S Golf Links Road. When you reach S Swan Road, turn left. Turn right at E Broadway Blvd and then right again on S Williams Blvd. (If you hit S Craycroft Rd, you've missed the turning). Continue down S Williams Blvd until you see the sign for 310 S Williams Blvd. Turn right and enter the parking lot - we are suite 160.

### Coming from the Airport:

Head north on S Tucson Blvd. Turn right on E Irvington Road and then, just after you cross under I-10, turn left on S Palo Verde Blvd. Keep left, and the road becomes S Alvernon Way. Turn right at E Broadway Blvd and then right again on S Williams Blvd. (If you hit S Craycroft Rd, you've missed the turning). Continue down S Williams Blvd until you see the sign for 310 S Williams Blvd. Turn right and enter the parking lot - we are suite 160.

**Parking:** Please use any of the available parking spaces.
