## Course Description

A detailed course description can be found at [www.consulting.ky/pmp.cfm](http://www.consulting.ky/pmp.cfm) This interactive course is built around Rita Mulcahy's, "PMP Exam Prep" text, a widely used PMP certification training tool, and the 2000 PMBOK. While participant input is encouraged, the focus of the course is kept on PMP exam preparation, not on discussing the merits or drawbacks of PMI's philosophies or testing procedures. The course meets the PMP certification requirement of 35 hours of formal training.

## Who should take this course ?

Course participants should be familiar with the certification process, and meet the PMP experience requirements prior to attending. You should also be reasonably familiar with modern project management techniques, as advocated by PMI, and be planning on sitting for the exam in the near future.

### IMPORTANT:

The updated PMP® exam (using the new 2004 PMBOK®) will deploy globally at 14.00 GMT on Friday, 30 September 2005. Applications to take the current exam will be accepted by PMI until 29 August 2005. Candidates submitting applications after 29 August will take the new exam.

**29th August 2005** Final date to submit applications to test on existing exam (PMBOK 2000)  
**24th September 2005** Final day to test on existing exam (PMBOK 2000)  
**30th September 2005** First day to test on new exam (PMBOK 2004)

### From North I-5:

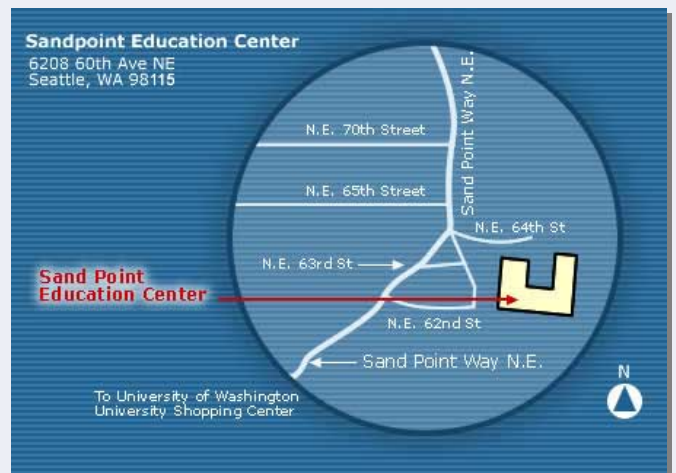
Take the Ravenna/NE 65th St Exit

### From I-5 South:

Exit NE 65th St.  
 Take NE 65th St. east all the way to the end  
 R on Sand Point Way NE  
 L on NE 62nd St.  
 NE 62nd St. becomes 60th Ave NE

### From Bellevue:

520 W to Montlake Blvd N.E. Exit  
 N on Montlake Blvd N.E. to N.E. 45th St.  
 E on N.E. 45th St  
 Stay on N.E. 45th St. Keep to the left, it will turn into Sand Point Way  
 R on N.E. 62nd St.
